Make sure you have the best hanging hardware for your frame by using the chart below.

- Weighing Your Options

To choose the best hardware, take into account your frame's size and weight, where hardware can be installed on it if needed, and the wall material it will be hung on.

- Pound for Pound

Easily weigh your frame using a bathroom scale. Weigh yourself, then hold the frame and weigh yourself again. The difference between the two is the weight of your frame!

- Securing the Goods
