SIZE: One size fits most adults

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee®, First Love (shown in Snowbaby), 5 oz. skeins of 143 yds. – 3 skeins
- Yarn needle



SIMPLE

CROCHET HOOK:

Size L-11 (8 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE: 8 hdc 6 rows = 4"

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch = chain

Dc = double crochet

Hdc = half double crochet

St = stitch

DIRECTIONS:

Row 1: (right side) Ch 4, 2 dc in 4th ch from hook.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), turn, 2 hdc in first dc, hdc in next dc, (hdc, dc) in last dc. (7 sts)

Next Row: Ch 3, turn, 2 hdc in first dc, hdc in each st across to last dc, (hdc, dc) in last dc.

Repeat next row until shawl measures 79" across the longest side, ending with a right side row. Finish off and weave in ends.
